4 Purpose of processing personal data	To facilitate the payment of grants, scholarships and awards, the Industrial Research Fund needs to obtain recipients' contact information, personal identity number and bank details. Grants of €1,000 or more must also be reported to the tax authorities.
5 Types of personal data	Recipients' name, contact information, personal identity number and bank details. Amount and purpose of the grant/scholarship/award.
6 Sources of personal data	Recipients provide the personal data stored in the grant, scholarship and award records.
7 Disclosure of personal data	Personal data will not be shared with third parties. Data may be disclosed to public authorities to comply with legal requirements.
8 Transfer of data outside the EU/EEA	Personal data will not be transferred outside the European Union (EU) or the European Economic Area (EEA).
9 Data protection principles	<p>Electronically processed data: Applications and personal data submitted via the Industrial Research Fund's e-form will be retained up until the end of February following the year of submission, after which the data will be destroyed.</p>

10 Right of access	Under the Personal Data Act, individuals have the right to access their personal data and request corrections to any inaccurate or incomplete details. 11 Right to rectification	The Data Controller will proactively correct any personal data it identifies as incorrect, unnecessary, incomplete or outdated.
